



If you are a resident in Ontario and travel in Ontario in 2022, you can receive a generous tax rebate at the end of the year.



What is an eligible expense?

Accommodation expenses for a leisure stay of less than a month in Ontario, at a short-term accommodation such as a:

- · hotel or motel
- resort
- lodge
- · bed-and-breakfast establishment
- cottage
- campground
- · vacation rental property



Should I keep my receipts?

Yes! Your invoices will need to include the following information:

- · Location of the accommodation
- The GST/HST paid
- The date of stay
- The name of the payer
- The amount that can reasonably be considered to be the accommodation portion of a stay
- · bed-and-breakfast establishment
- cottage
- campground
- vacation rental property



Filing as an individual?

You can claim up to \$1,000 in accommodation costs, and you will receive a 20% rebate on that amount.



Filing as a Couple or a Family?

If you are filing as a couple or family, you can claim up to \$2,000 in accommodation costs and you will receive a 20% rebate on that amount.

Only one individual per family can claim the credit for the year. Your claim can include the eligible expenses of your spouse or common-law partner and your eligible children. If you do not have a spouse or common-law partner, or eligible child, you can claim your own eligible expenses for the credit.
